Routes and Travel times



EUROSTAR crosses the Channel Tunnel and runs at speeds of up to 186 mph (300km/h) on high-speed lines in France, Belgium and Great Britain. Clients board the train in the centre of London and arrive in the centre of Paris 2 hours and 15 minutes later or in the centre of Brussels 1 hour 51 minutes later.

BUSINESS PREMIER

Business Premier has been created to meet Business travellers' expectations (flexibility of ticket, wireless in the business lounges, wide range of services on board, etc).

Before boarding

- A fast lane check-in: check-in closes 10 minutes before departure
- Dedicated Ticket Desk and check-in desks
- Access to the departure lounge and shops once checked-in (at London, Paris and Brussels stations)
- An exclusive Business Premier Lounge access in Paris, London, Ashford, Ebbsfleet and Brussels: state-of-the-art design, peaceful and well-equipped space with comfortable seats, free Wifi connection, complimentary newspapers available, snack, power sockets to load computers and cell phones.

VI. Check-in procedures

- Leisure Select/Standard Premier and Std Class Clients (Individuals) must check-in at least 30 minutes before the departure of the train or will not be allowed to board Eurostar.
- Minimum check-in time for groups of more than 24 passengers 45mn 1h before train's departure time.
- A last minute check-in for Business Premier clients is available 10 minutes before departure time.
- Client must not forget immigration documents and passport (identity card, passport, visa if necessary) to permit entry into the destination country.



- What is it?

Culture Connect is a unique partnership between Eurostar and specially selected museums and galleries in London, Paris and Brussels.

The offer applies as follow:

- if the traveller is travelling from London to Paris or Brussels he can get 2 for 1 entry to paying exhibitions or permanent collections at any of the French or Belgian museums and galleries listed below.
- if the traveller is travelling from Paris or Brussels to London he can get 2 for 1 entry to paying exhibitions or permanent collections at any of the Londoners museums and galleries listed below.

The offer is available for up to 5 days after arrival at destination.

- How does it work?

The traveller has simply to show his ticket at any of the museums and galleries listed below and get 2 for 1 entry to all paying exhibitions or permanent collections.
