



## Enjoy the legendary German seamless quality of service and comfort for your trips in Germany and beyond...

I. Routes & Travel times The ICE (Intercity-Express) is the fastest and most comfortable way of travelling on the Deutsche Bahn network, reaching speeds of up to 320 km/h, and new standards of excellence.

ICE trains link nearly all major German cities at hourly or two-hourly intervals and go also to Switzerland (Zurich, Interlaken and Basel); Austria (Vienna), Belgium (Liège, Brussels), France (Paris), the Netherlands (Amsterdam) and Denmark (Copenhagen).

**ICE Sprinter** On some lines ICE Sprinter trains offer virtually **non-stop connections between major German cities**. The Berlin - Frankfurt, Hamburg - Koeln and Hamburg - Frankfurt ICE Sprinter shorten your travelling time up to one hour, saving you valuable time. The sprinter is perfect for business travel. A special supplement is required. Prices are very affordable. On the mentioned lines there is usually a ICE Sprinter connection in the morning and in the evening.

Onboard services

- Seats can be adjusted in depth and inclination (up to 40 degrees)
- Air-conditioned carriages
- Fixed or hinged tables at all seats
- Panoramic lounges in the first and last coach of some ICE trains (1st and 2nd class)
- Integrated audio connection in the armrest, 3 radio stations: classical music/jazz, rock/pop and the children's channel
- Low noise level
- Lockers available in the vestibules for the luggage: the deposit will be returned to you when you remove your luggage
- Service crew on the train takes orders for taxis or porters
- Trolley service with beverages and snacks in 2nd class coaches
- You can access the Internet in all DB Lounges and on all ICE trains which feature the HotSpot logo on the following routes:

## Special First Class features

**ICE First Class offers a high standard of service including:**

- Some coaches feature individual video screens at the seat
- Real leather seats
- Electric sockets for laptops or DVD players can be found in most 1st class carriages
- A selection of beverages and meals from menus can be served at your seat on request
- Complimentary newspapers available
- Quiet zones are reserved for passengers who want to travel in peace.
- On some International lines a small snack and soft drinks (coffee, tea, mineral water, orange juice) are offered free of charge.
- In major stations: DB Lounges. In Berlin, Hamburg, Frankfurt and Munich in addition a dedicated area exclusively for first class customers with free internet access



## Other services

- All ICE trains convey a Bordbistro and/or Bordrestaurant
- Depending on the time of the day, the traveller can choose from various breakfast menus to suit any taste or main dishes from the à la carte menu. In addition to the standard dishes, the menu often features German and European regional specialities freshly prepared. The Bordbistro serves snacks and a wide selection of beverages which you can enjoy there or take back to your seat.
- In 1st Class coaches a selection of beverages and meals from our menus can be served at your seat on request. Snacks and beverages are also available at your seat in 2nd Class.
- Facilities for disabled travellers

Check-in procedures

- There are no check-in or customs procedures before boarding ICE trains.
- For International destinations, ticket control and passport checks will occur on boarding the train.
- ICE indicated platforms are available for passengers holding ICE tickets.
