FRECCIAROSSA

The trains reach the speed up to 360 km/h.

- Milan - Rome - Milan: 72 daily connections

On peak hours, from 8 am to 10 am and from 4 pm to 8 pm, 12 connections between Milan and Rome and 13 from Rome to Milan.

28 Frecciarossa, no stop take 2h59

28 Frecciarossa, stopping at Bologna and Florence, take 3h30

6 Frecciarossa, from Milan Rogoredo to Rome Tiburtina, take only 2h45

8 Frecciarossa from Milan Porta Garibaldi to Rome Termini stopping at Bologna and Florence Campo Marte.

2 Frecciarossa stop at Piacenza, Parma, Reggio Emilia and Modena.

- Milan - Naples - Milan: 36 daily connections

6 Frecciarossa Fast take 4h10

6 Frecciarossa, stopping at Rome, take 4h25

24 Frecciarossa stopping at Bologna Centrale, Florence Santa Maria Novella and Rome Termini take 4h55

- Turin - Rome - Turin: 10 daily connections

8 Frecciarossa (6 more than in 2009) connect Turin to Rome in 4h10' (1h30' shorter than in 2009). The train stop in Milano Porta Garibaldi, Bologna Centrale and Firenze Campo Marte.

2 Frecciarossa stopping at Milan Centrale only, connect Turin to Rome in 4h19'.

- **Bologna - Florence - Bologna: 70 daily connections** Thank to the completion of the AV/AC line, Frecciarossa and Frecciargento trains connect Bologna to Florence in 37 minutes

- **Rome - Naples - Rome: 40 daily connections**

FRECCIARGENTO

Frecciargento trains reach up to 250 Km/h speed. The Frecciargento trains are dedicated to passengers travelling between Rome and Venice, Verona, Bari/Lecce, Lamezia Terme/Reggio Calabria. The trains are designed to offer the best level of comfort.

- **Rome- Venice - Rome: 26 daily connections**

4 Frecciargento Fast take 3h30

22 Frecciargento in 3h48

- **Rome - Verona - Rome: 6 daily connections**

2 Frecciargento continue up to Brescia allowing passengers to benefit from the recent doubling of the line Bologna-Verona and take 3hrs only between Verona and Rome.

- **Rome - Bari - Rome: 10 connections**

4 Frecciargento Fast take 3h59

- **Rome - Reggio Calabria - Rome: 10 connections**

2 Frecciargento Fast between Rome and Lamezia Terme

8 connections Rome - Reggio Calabria.

FRECCIABIANCA

- Frecciabianca trains connect Milan to Venice, Udine e Trieste; Genova e Rome; Bari and Lecce. Speed and comfort for passengers travelling on the traditional line.
