PARIS-MOSCOW

Routes & Travel times

- This overnight train service leave from Paris Gare de l'Est and arrive at Moscow Bieloruskaia station and vv.
- This train runs 3 times a week during the summer and twice in winter.

- Here is a description of the trip which lasts 2 full days, please note that there is a stopover of 6 hours in Berlin.

Day 1: Departure from Paris Gare de l'Est in the morning

Day 2: Arrival at Berlin (the traveller get a few hours free to visit the city centre, go for shopping or have a typical German lunch!). Departure from Berlin in the afternoon.

Day 3: Arrival in Moscow in the evening.

Onboard services

This train has all the facilities ensuring high standards of travel including:

- **First Class**

There are 5 First Class compartments each made up with 2 beds to accommodate a maximum of 2 passengers. Sheets, 1 duvet, 2 pillows, 2 bath towels, 1 welcome kit per person are included.

- **Second Class**

There are 5 Second class compartments, each made up with 3 beds accommodating a maximum of 3 passengers. Sheets, 1 duvet, 1 pillow, 1 bath towel, 1 welcome kit per person are included.

Each compartment can be individually locked by a key. Toilets are located at each end of the coaches.

- **Other onboard services**

Meals are not included in the ticket price

Access to the bar-buffet car

There are 2 dedicated train managers in each coach, to make the trip more pleasant and assist the passengers with any questions they might have.

Check-in procedures

- Ticket control and passport checks will occur before boarding Paris-Moscow or vv Night train.
 - It opens 30 minutes before the train leaves and is closed 2 minutes before departure.
